

WOOSTER ESCAPES.

Boy Who Fired Industrial School Barn At Large.

By punching a hole in the ceiling of a bathroom adjoining the hospital, where they were confined with mumps, with an iron bar taken from a bed, and crawling several hundred feet along the ridgepole of a peaked roof Fred Wooster of West Rutland, age 20 years, and Robert Harrington, 18, of Bradford, escaped from the house of correction at Rutland and are still at large.

It is believed the fugitives were in Brattleboro Saturday, and escaped in the direction of South Vernon on a freight train. No further trace of them has been obtained.

Wooster was sent to the house of correction from the Vermont Industrial school at Vergennes for arson, having been sentenced to the school by Rutland city court for stealing a bicycle. Harrington was doing a year's sentence for burglary.

A reward of \$50 is offered for the apprehension of the young men.
