WPA to Train Women For Beauty Parlor Jobs

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Schools to train beauty experts will be opened soon in five boroughs of New York under the auspices of the Works Progress Administration, according to an announcement yesterday by Viotor F. Ridder, local WPA head. Women who are now enrolled with the WPA and others receiving home relief will be eligible for the training.

The plan for the training schools is being formulated by Major Wilfred E. Boughton, head of the WPA re-employment bureau, and Mrs. Sarah S. Dennen, director of the women's division of the WPA.

Major Boughton said that officials of the National Association of Cosmetologists and Beauticians had informed him that a marked improvement in that industry had created room for skilled and trained employes.
