

Women skaters gear up for season finale

The Middlebury women's ice hockey team returned to their winning ways last week with road wins over the University of Vermont (UVM) and Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute (RPI). In doing so, they ran their overall record to 14-8 and positioned themselves for a solid season finale this coming weekend at the ECAC Independent Tournament in Boston.

The contest against UVM allowed the Panthers an opportunity to vent their frustrations after losing in the championship game of their own Middlebury Tournament only three

days before.

The venting began with first period goals from the Hefner sisters, Jen and Kelly, off assists from sophomore Torrey Hinman and first-year forward Helen Froelich.

The Panther offensive attack did not stop there, however. They exploded for four more goals in the second period, two off the stick of Jen Hefner and one apiece from Whit Parks '97 and Laurie Odden
